

- It's supported by thousands of developers around the world!
- ✗ It's going to solve your problems

- * There is commercial support if needed
- * There are consultants and free-lancers available
- * Or you can take it in-house

MULTIPLE APPROACHES

- * Security is always an issue, regardless of software
- * Drupal community can respond quickly -- and has
- Regular updates are part of the process (and you get notified)
- Detailed best practices on how to code: https://www.drupal.org/writing-secure-code

FEAR OF UPGRADES / LOSS OF SUPPORT

YOU ARE NOT ALONE

- * Upgrades: yes, Drupal upgrades on a regular basis
- ★ Upgrades: no, there isn't a straight migration path
- But the timeline is in your favor -- D7 is likely to be supported for 5-7 years

WHAT DO I DO WITH ALL THIS STUFF? WHERE DO I EVEN START?

GET THEM FROM POINT A TO POINT B...

- * Explain the process -- both during and after the project
- Admin tools: make them friendly! only show people what they need to see
- ★ Tell a story -- where they are the hero
